Subject: Development of Monitoring Application for "Apna Meter Apni Reading" Initiative

The Prime Minister of Pakistan launched the "Apna Meter Apni Reading" mobile application on June 28, 2025, to empower consumers to submit real-time images of their electricity meter readings on the scheduled date. This initiative is a significant step toward reducing overbilling complaints, enhancing transparency, and improving consumer trust in the billing system.

To monitor the initiative's implementation, the Minister (Power Division) has directed the development of a centralized monitoring application. This application must track usage by consumers and response from field formations, with drill-down capability from DISCO to circle, division, sub-division and feeder levels. It should allow the Ministry, PPMC and DISCOs remote access to real-time data.
